

CLEMONS TREE FARM

1941 – 1961

The 75 foot Douglas fir being shipped to Washington, D. C. was grown on the Clemons Tree Farm which was dedicated by Weyerhaeuser Company in 1941 as America's first tree farm. Since that time, the program for management of privately owned forestlands on a perpetual crop basis has spread to 47 states where more than 55 million acres of timberlands are carefully managed under the tree farm plan providing wood, water, wildlife and recreation.
